55-year-old, male, HIV+, nasofibrosopic biopsy revealed non- Hodgkins  
lymphoma. Both patients died. Conclusions:

Orbital involvement in lymphoma in patient with AIDS is uncommon. But  
important include this in differential diagnosis of orbital disease. The diagnosis  
must be made with biopsy. The prognosis is not good.
